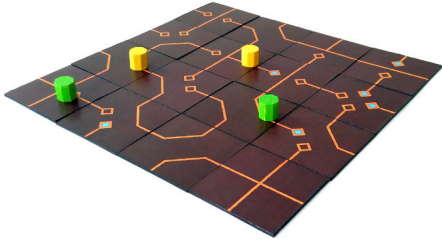

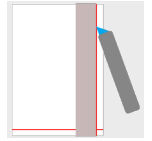
Material needed

- 4 markers, 2 of one color each; app. 1 cm in size (e.g. wooden cubes in yellow and green)
- 1 sheet of paper and glue (or self adhesive paper)
- 1 sheet of cardboard (min. 21 cm x 21 cm) for the tiles (e.g. 1 mm thick greyboard)
- Optional for printed backs: 1 sheet of paper (sticky)
- 1 sheet of paper for the rules

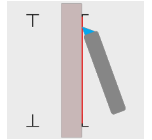
Building the tiles

- 1 Print the page labeled “Liniell tiles front” and glue it to the cardboard.
- 2 Optional for printed backs (full color version only):
 - a Cut the front of the cardboard **along the alignment lines** using a sharp knife (cutter) and a ruler.
 - b Print the page labeled “Liniell tiles back” and cut it **along the alignment lines**.
 - c Glue the sheet to the back of your cardboard so that the front and back alignment corners  and the two alignment edges of paper and cardboard match up.



- 3 Cut between the cut marks using a sharp knife (cutter) and a ruler.


Be careful to **only cut between the**  **marks** and do not cut over the edge of the board. This way you can use the cut marks for both vertical and horizontal cuts.

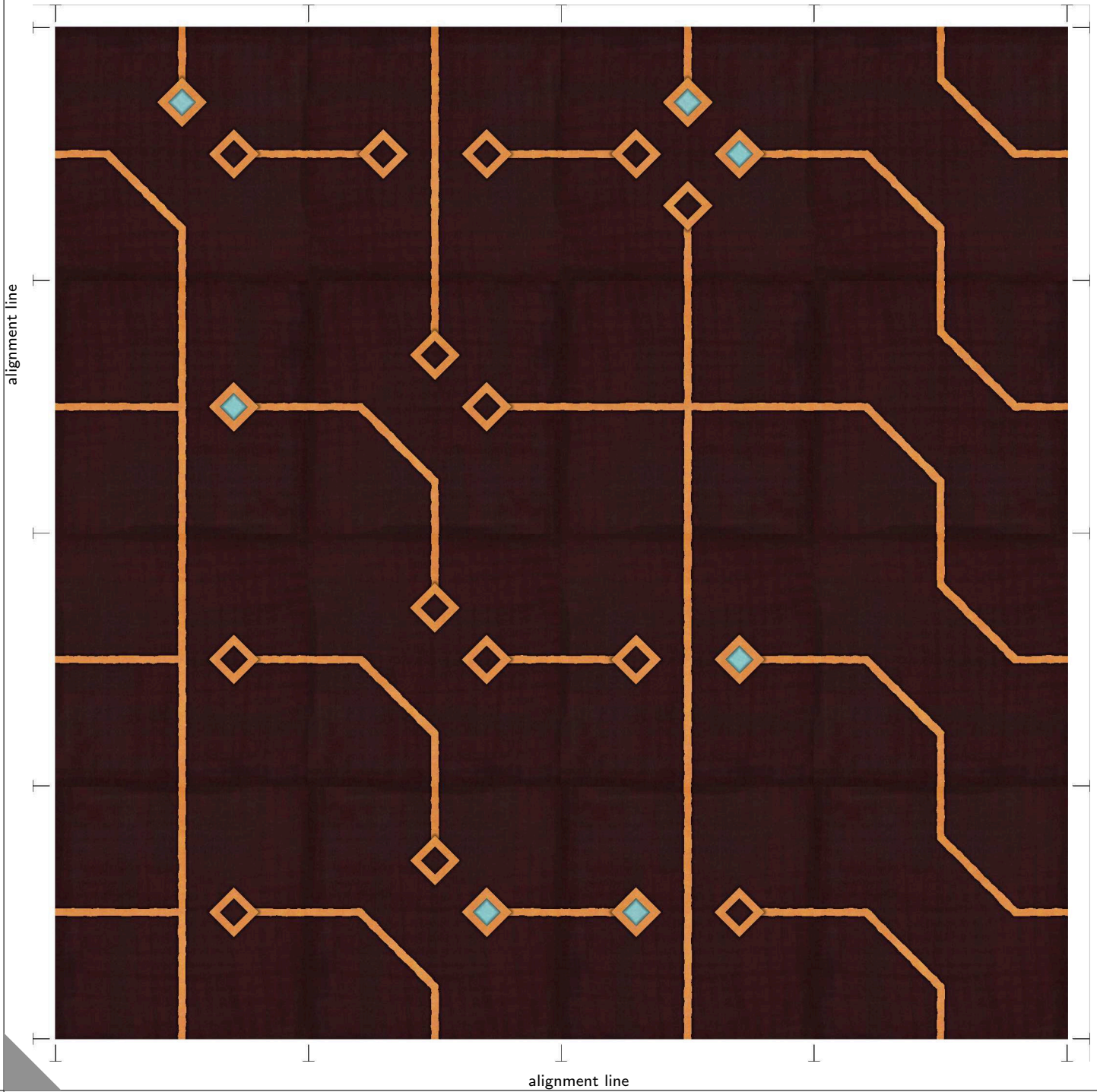

Cutting tips

- When cutting thicker cardstock, it is easier to perform one cut in multiple passes.
- When cutting with your right hand, start from the rightmost vertical cut, then move on to the left. Rotate the page by 90 degrees and repeat for the horizontal cuts. When cutting with your left hand, go from left to right.
- When cutting with scissors: Use a pencil to draw thin lines between the  marks. Then cut along these lines.
